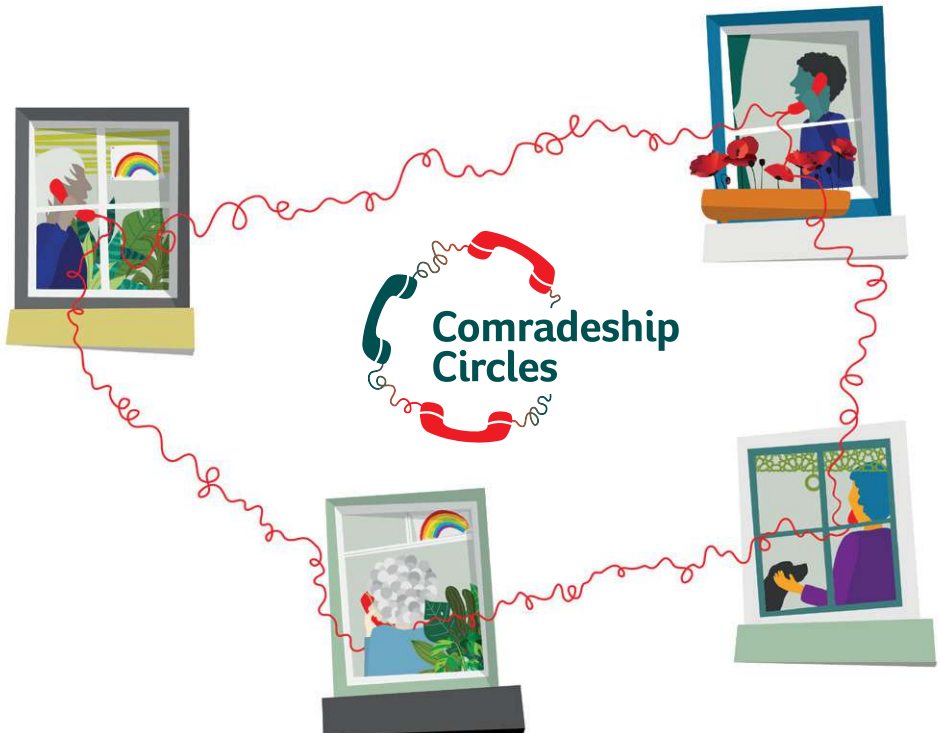

Comradeship Circles could be for you. Connect with a group of other armed forces veterans and form new friendships through a weekly phone call. It's for any veteran of the British Armed Forces aged 50 or over, or their partners.

What is a Comradeship Circle?

A Comradeship Circle is a weekly chat over the phone but instead of talking to just one other person, you'll be talking to a group of roughly 6 people. All you need to take part is a landline or mobile phone.



Who can join?

It's for any veteran of the British Armed Forces aged 50 or over and their spouses, partners, widows or widowers. This includes all branches and forces, from regulars to reservists and National Servicemen.
